HOW TO CONSIGN

STEP 1: CONTACT US

Email photos of your item(s) with a detailed description to:

info@coastconsignment.com

Include information like brand, age, condition, and any other relevant details

STEP 2: ITEM APPRAISAL

You will receive an email response from our appraisers detailing the item(s) we can accept and the overall value. We will arrange a time for your items to be dropped off.

STEP 3: DELIVERING YOUR ITEMS

Items can be dropped off between Mondays-Fridays **by appointment** by the consignor or by movers. If you require movers, we have a list of trusted moving companies.

STEP 4: RECEIVING PAYMENT

Payments are made by cheque (mailed or picked-up in store) or by E-transfer once all items have sold. Please contact us to arrange payment and confirm your details.

ALL ITEMS MUST BE SALE READY UPON ARRIVAL

This means cleaned, vacuumed, undamaged, and with all working parts. We do not accept damaged or dirty items, we do not restore or repair, and these will be returned to you at your cost. We also do not take items that have been in storage lockers for more than 6 months.

WHAT WE CAN SELL

- *Furniture (contemporary, new, and vintage)*
- *Antiques (depending on style and era)*
- *Rugs (wool and /or silk, sisal, sea grass)*
- *Lamps and chandeliers (with all parts)*
- *Artwork (originals and very limited edition prints), folk art, and sculptures*
- *Fine china and collectibles, crystal, and sterling silver and silver plate (must be cleaned and polished)*
- *Small fashion accessories like costume or fine jewelry, handbags, and evening bags*
- *Garden furniture, accessories and containers*
- *Mirrors*
- *Small musical instruments in working condition*

WHAT WE CAN'T SELL

- *Garage sale leftovers*
- *Fitness equipment*
- *Shelving units or other furniture in MDF, particle board, or chipboard*
- *Entertainment/TV armoires*
- *Old electronics such as boxy TVs, VCRs, kitchen appliances, personal care appliances, fans, or cleaning appliances*
- *Damaged goods: cracked, chipped, badly stained, incomplete (missing parts/pieces), and odorous (smoke, moth balls)*
- *Pianos, organs, and other large instruments*
- *Old fashioned patterned upholstered sofas and chairs*
- *Oversized furniture and extra large furniture*
- *Mattresses*

HOW LONG DOES IT TAKE TO SELL MY GOODS?

It depends on the number of items in your account. The typical period to sell your items is 1-6 months.

HOW DO I GET UPDATES ON MY ACCOUNT?

- The consignor must call or email us for an account status update at least 4 weeks after the items arrive at Coast Consignment at info@coastconsignment.com
- Coast Consignment does not call or email consignors with updates
- It is the consignors' responsibility to update Coast Consignment with address, email, and/or telephone number changes promptly

MINIMUM VALUE REQUIRED FOR CONSIGNMENT

We require a minimum combined value of \$700-1000 to start a consignor account and often don't accept 1 item only if it does not have enough value. Please check with us to see if your item can be consigned.

PROFESSIONAL APPRAISALS

Coast Consignment offers professional itemized appraisals for insurance, divorce, and estates for a fee. Fees depend on the location, purpose of the report, level of detail required, number of items, and amount of research required. Minimum fee is \$250. Call or email for an estimate.
